Environmental protection concerns span a wide variety of issues, including clean air, water quality, chemical security, and environmental aspects of other major issue areas such as transportation and defense. This issue brief provides an overview of key environmental issues that are receiving or may receive attention in the 109th Congress. The sections on specific issues contain references to more detailed and extensive CRS reports on the subjects covered. (It should be noted that this issue brief treats mainly pollution-related matters; for natural resource management issues, see CRS Report RL32699, Natural Resources: Selected Issues for the 109th Congress. ) A number of environmental measures have been the subject of congressional actions. On April 21, 2005, the House passed H. R. 6, the Energy Policy Act of 2005. An omnibus energy package, the bill contains numerous environmentally related provisions. Perhaps the most controversial include liability protection for the gasoline additive methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE), a renewable fuel standard, streamlined environmental permitting, and opening the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge (ANWR) to oil and gas explorations. Early in the year the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee held hearings and scheduled markup of S. 131, the Clear Skies Act. However, the bill failed on a . . .
