The face and neck are of black marble; while his dress, and the dogs collar round his neck with a bell, are of grey and white. Cj)e CapeBttg represents the Battle of Solebay, which was fought on May 28th, 1672, between the English and French fleets under the Duke of York and the Comte dEtres, against the Dutch fleet under De Ruyter.
